Position: Men's Spiritual Coach (part-time)

Duties: General

1. To help bring about God's kingdom on earth and minister with the love of Jesus to those Regeneration serves
2. To support other Regeneration staff in a way that reflects God's call to be one body
3. To operate as a faithful steward of the resources God's people make available to Regeneration
4. To walk in personal integrity, recognizing that personal conduct impacts relationship, reputation, and our capacity to serve well together

Duties: Function Related

1. Provide one-to-one spiritual coaching for men struggling with sexual and relational sins and brokenness (e.g. sexual addictions, same-sex attractions and behavior, past sexual abuse, marital struggles, etc.); and occasionally, husbands and wives in recovery.
2. Collaborate with Regeneration's team to fulfill Regeneration's larger vision and mission, including assisting with:
 - a. Regeneration events (programs, conferences, fundraisers, trainings, church teachings)
 - b. Creating ministry resources (blogs, podcasts, books, and videos)
 - c. Networking and collaborating with pastors, counselors, and those doing related work
 - d. Fundraising
 - e. Responding to phone and email inquiries
3. Other tasks and projects, as needed/assigned

Core Competencies

- Required qualifications:
 - Spiritual maturity, pastoral/shepherding gifts, and a commitment to ongoing personal and professional growth and integrity
 - Pastoral or professional experience helping men who struggle with a scope of sexual and relational issues, including but not limited to sexual addictions, same-sex attractions, and past sexual abuse
 - Commitment to upholding and communicating God's design for gender, marriage, and sex as revealed in Scripture according to traditional, orthodox Christian teaching.
 - Demonstrated dedication to personal sexual, relational, and spiritual integrity as outlined in Regeneration's Board and Staff Standards
 - Proven ability and desire to work well with a team

- Additional preferred* qualifications:
 - Masters degree in mental health, pastoral care, or related field
 - Trained in listening/healing prayer
 - Experience with sexual and relational healing programs such as *Living Waters*
 - Familiarity with Theology of the Body
 - Familiarity with Regeneration Ministries
